## Unit Information

There are 64 ambulatory clinics at OU Health offering primary care, pediatrics, women's health, geriatrics medicine specialty, surgery, behavioral health, and more. Ambulatory clinics are typically more 'fast paced' in nature due to the volume of patients being seen. Despite the high volume of patients being seen, the care team still have the ability to build a relationship with the patient as they provide care in their day-to-day life.

Nursing roles include care team rooming activities, procedure assistance, triage, care coordination, and more.
