Subject: Accreditation Site Visit – Oklahoma Children's Air Kids

The Commission on Accreditation of Medical Transport Systems (CAMTS) will conduct an accreditation site visit of Oklahoma Children's Air Kids on April 29-30, 2026. The purpose of this visit is to evaluate the program's compliance with nationally established medical transport standards. The results of the site visit will be used to determine whether, and under what conditions, accreditation should be awarded to the program.

CAMTS accreditation standards address issues of patient care and safety within the transport environment. Individuals who believe they have pertinent or valid information regarding patient care or transport safety may request a public information interview with CAMTS site surveyors during the site visit. Requests for public information interviews must be made in writing and sent to CAMTS no later than 10 business days before the site survey begins, indicating the nature of the information to be provided. The Commission will acknowledge such requests in writing or by telephone and will notify the program as well as the interviewee regarding the date, time, and place of any scheduled interviews.
