## **Unit Information**

At OU Health University of Oklahoma Medical Center, you'll find Oklahoma's leader in Level 1 Trauma, the highest possible national designation verified by the American College of Surgeons (ACS). Patients receive expert care from a multidisciplinary team of doctors, nurses, healthcare staff and specialists capable of treating the most severe and critical injuries 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We offer 30 main ED beds and six trauma bays, with only experienced nurses eligible to work in the trauma bays. New nurse graduates require up to two years of training to achieve eligibility to work in the trauma bays.
