ABLE Tech Programs & Services

State AT Act Program

- Federally funded through the Administration for Community Living (ACL) of the US Department of Health and Human Services, made possible through the Assistive Technology (AT) Act of 1998, as amended in 2022 (ATA 2022).
- Supports state/territory efforts to improve the provision of AT to individuals with disabilities of all ages through comprehensive, statewide programs that are consumer-responsive.

Oklahoma ABLE Tech's Mission

Our mission is to improve the lives of all Oklahomans by providing assistive technology (AT) devices and services, financing opportunities, digital accessibility services, advocacy, and education.

Oklahoma ABLE Tech – Core Programs

Oklahoma ABLE Tech has 5 core programs to increase the access to and acquisition of AT for individuals with disabilities.

- Device Demonstration

State-Level AT Act Programs FFY 22 National Rankings

- Device Demonstration: #1 out of 56 programs participating with a total of 7,634 demonstrations
- Device Short-Term Loan: #2 out of 56 programs with a total of 1,863 loans
- Financial Loans: #1 out of 29 programs participating with a total of 342 devices
- Device Exchange: #1 out of 27 programs participating with a total of 410 devices
- **Device Reuse: #14 out of 53 programs** participating with a total of **2,042 devices**

What is AT?

Assistive Technology (AT) is any item, device, or piece of equipment used to maintain or improve a person's capabilities, allowing them to function more independently in completing education, employment, recreation, and daily living activities.

AT Services

AT is also the service that directly assists an individual with a disability in the selection, acquisition, or use of an AT device.



ABLE Tech's Device Short-Term Loan Program

Device Short-Term Loan Program

- To assist in AT decision-making
- To serve as a loaner while the consumer is waiting for device repair or funding
- To provide accommodation on a short-term basis
- To support professional development

Device Short-Term Loan Program Tips

- Short-term loans are at **no cost**
- Devices can be borrowed for up to six-weeks
- Can request up to three items at a time
- Do **NOT** included minor's name on the application

Device Short-Term Loan Program Process

- Submit Application
- All loans are shipped via UPS and unless the item is unavailable, will arrive within 1-2 weeks
- Should the device you requested not be available to loan, you will be added to the waitlist to receive the equipment
- Borrowed items are delivered by mail or may be picked up in person
- To send back the device use the provided return shipping label or drop off the device in person

- Register for an Oklahoma (NATADS) ABLE Tech account
 - Note: Must select AT Program: Oklahoma ABLE Tech
- Search device short-term loan inventory
- Add device to loan cart
- Click view loan cart in the green box that appears at the top of the screen
- Submit device loan request

Reutilization Program

The purpose of the Device Reutilization Program is to allow individuals to acquire items through Reuse and Exchange activities.

Device Reuse

- ABLE Tech staff retrieves donated equipment
- Sanitizes and refurbishes devices
- Works with vendors to repair the equipment if needed
- Reassigns DME devices to the best-matched Oklahoman

Device Exchange Program

The Device Exchange Program database is also available to help individuals sell, give away, or request gently used DME from other Oklahomans.



ABLE Tech's Financial Loan Program

Financial Loan Program

- Fixed 5% interest rate for life of the loan
- Easy, flexible repayment terms
- May be used to cover copays
- Payments made directly to the vendor
- Special qualify terms for applicants who have limited income or bankruptcy due to a disability-related circumstance


