

can all help individuals recall memories they might struggle to remember otherwise.


- Animal Therapy

Components of a Sensory Room






- 1. Bubble tube.
- 2. Lighting.
- 3. Fiber Optic Lighting
- 4. Beanbag like chairs.
- 5. Weighted blankets
- 6. Interactive Wall Boards.
- 7. Rocking chairs.
- 8. Stereo or MP3 Player with Headphones.
- 9. Therapy balls.
- 10.Lighting/projector that can display various colors & patterns.




Ceiling Tile Light Filters
