AT OKLAHOMA CHILDREN'S – SUMMER 2026

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

OU Health and Sodexo are proud to participate in the USDA's Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), offering free, nutritious meals to **children 18 and under** during the months when school meals aren't available. This federally funded program helps ensure kids continue to receive balanced nutrition throughout the summer.

Participants can enjoy a **free lunch** that meets USDA guidelines, including a hot entrée, a choice of fruit, and their preferred milk option. All items are preapproved for quality and nutrition, helping bridge the summer nutrition gap and reinforcing OU Health's commitment to child and community well-being.

HOW IT WORKS

- 1. Start at the Entrée Hot Line.**
- 2. Choose approved items from the pre-set menu**, including a choice of fruit (apple, banana, or an orange) and a choice of milk. *Additional items will be charged.*
- 3. Please check in at the register** for meal count.

Note: Children are required to eat in the cafeteria and are not allowed to share food.
