The Adult Surgical Transplant Unit is a 32-bed unit at OU Health. We care for patients with different levels of severity, including both those in medical/surgical and stepdown status. We focus on pre-and post-operative inpatient care for patients undergoing abdominal transplants—specifically liver, kidney, and pancreas transplant candidates. Caregivers in our role are essential in the transplant process. They support patients from the initial consideration for an organ transplant, to the preparation for transplant surgery and finally for discharge home.
