- Ensure your cleaning product is EPA-Approved
 - Epa.gov/listn
- Read the Directions
- Pre-Clean the Surface
- Follow the contact time directions
- Wear Gloves and Practice good hand hygiene
- Lock it up- Secure cleaning product for safe storage











Safe Visitation Policy

- Specific and Detailed
- Limitations-# of visitors
 - Out of State
 - COVID signs/symptoms, history, testing requirements, vaccination
- Points of Entry and Exit out of building
- Use of Masks/PPE
- Social Distancing
- Hand Hygiene












QI Measures effected by Social Isolation



 - Acknowledge that visitation is not necessarily a linear process adjustments may have to be made to the visitation program based on community and facility COVID-19 status
